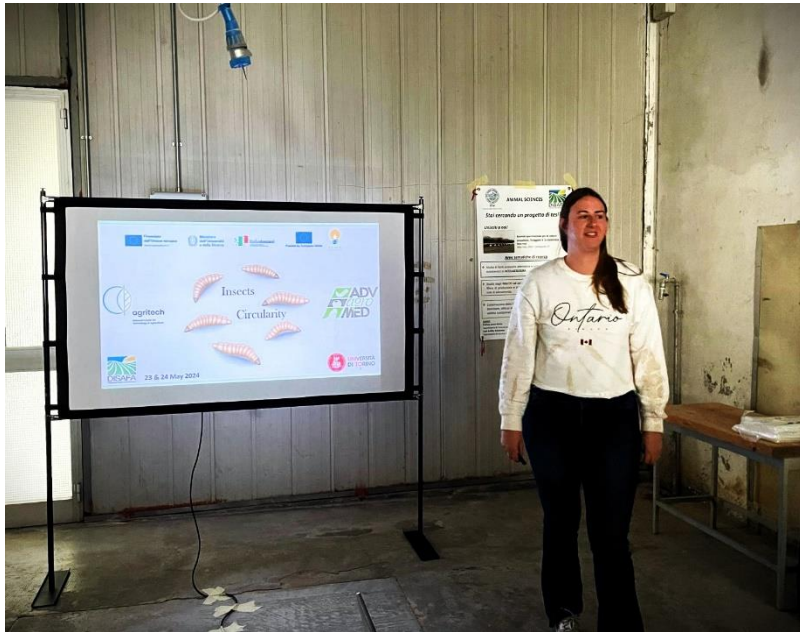


Prof. Laura Gasco and her research unit, developed classes dedicated to the two species (*Hermetia illucens* and *Tenebrio molitor*) reared at the Experimental Facility Tetto Frati of the Department of Agricultural, Forest and Food Sciences of Turin University. The workshop lasted two days with a series of theoretical-practical activities.





The event was a time of discussion about the use of insects within the nutrition of the main livestock species, as well as an important opportunity to share the Advagromed Project by Dr. Sara Bellezza Oddon and Prof. Ilaria Biasato presentations.



At the end of the two days of training, participants had the opportunity to form discussion groups aiming at the application of the knowledge acquired.





The workshop also hosted Dr. Bordignon from the University of Padova with a speech focused on the sustainability of the insect rearing and the measurements of its Life Cycle Assessment.
