The Department of Agricultural, Forest and Food Sciences (DISAFA) of the University of Turin [UNITO, coordinator of the ADVAGROMED project], the Italian National Research Council and the Department of Veterinary Sciences have organized a workshop day (Photo 1) addressed to all the people interested to the insect rearing (farmer, students, stakeholder, etc..). The workshop took place at the Department of Agricultural, Forest and Food Sciences (Largo Paolo Braccini 2, 10095 Grugliasco, TO). A total of about 70 people has participated.

After the inaugural greetings of Director of the DISAFA Carlo Grignani (Photo 2), the prof. Laura Gasco illustrated the Project in progress of the Animal Science research group and, specifically, the ADVAGROMED project aims, actions and partners. Subsequently, during the morning, four speech were carried out by experts of the insect sector (Photo 3):

- Tax legislation for insect producers (Dr. Filomena Maio – Confagricoltura)
- Food law in novel food: regulation and examples (Lwy. Dario Dongo – Wiise Srl)
- Animal health legislation in insect farms (Dr. Riccardo Prato – ASL TO3)
- Novel food chain with edible insects 100% made in Italy (Dr. Carlotta Todaro Fila – Alia Insect Farm Srl)

At the end of the morning, participants were offered the opportunity to ask questions to speakers.

Before the lunch break a panel test of chicken meat was carried out in order to evaluate the presence/absence of differences in terms of flavor, texture and color of

the final products derived from animals fed on insect-based diets (*Tenebrio molitor*, *Hermetia illucens* meals and a mixture between the two).

In the afternoon two different round tables (Photo 4) were carried out and moderated by the journalist Chiara Di Paola (Journal: Il Fatto Alimentare). The first had as protagonist insect farmers of black soldier fly [Côme Gidou, Mutatec (France); Giuseppe Tresso, BEF Biosystems (Italy) and Giacomo Zeni, BugsLife], and cricket (Ivan Albano, Italian Cricket Farm, Italy). The second was focused on the application of the insect-derived products, such as feed, aquaculture (Umberto Luzzana, Skretting group), pig and poultry (Alessandro Galli, Ferrero Mangimi Srl) and pet-food (Davide Storino, DL Novelfood Srl) sectors, food production (Rinaldo Stefanutto, Fucibo Italia Srl) and agronomy (Roberto Longo, Hello Nature Srl). Also in this case, participants had the opportunity to interact directly with experts in the development of the insect sector in Italy, asking questions and discussing the most important issues of this period.
